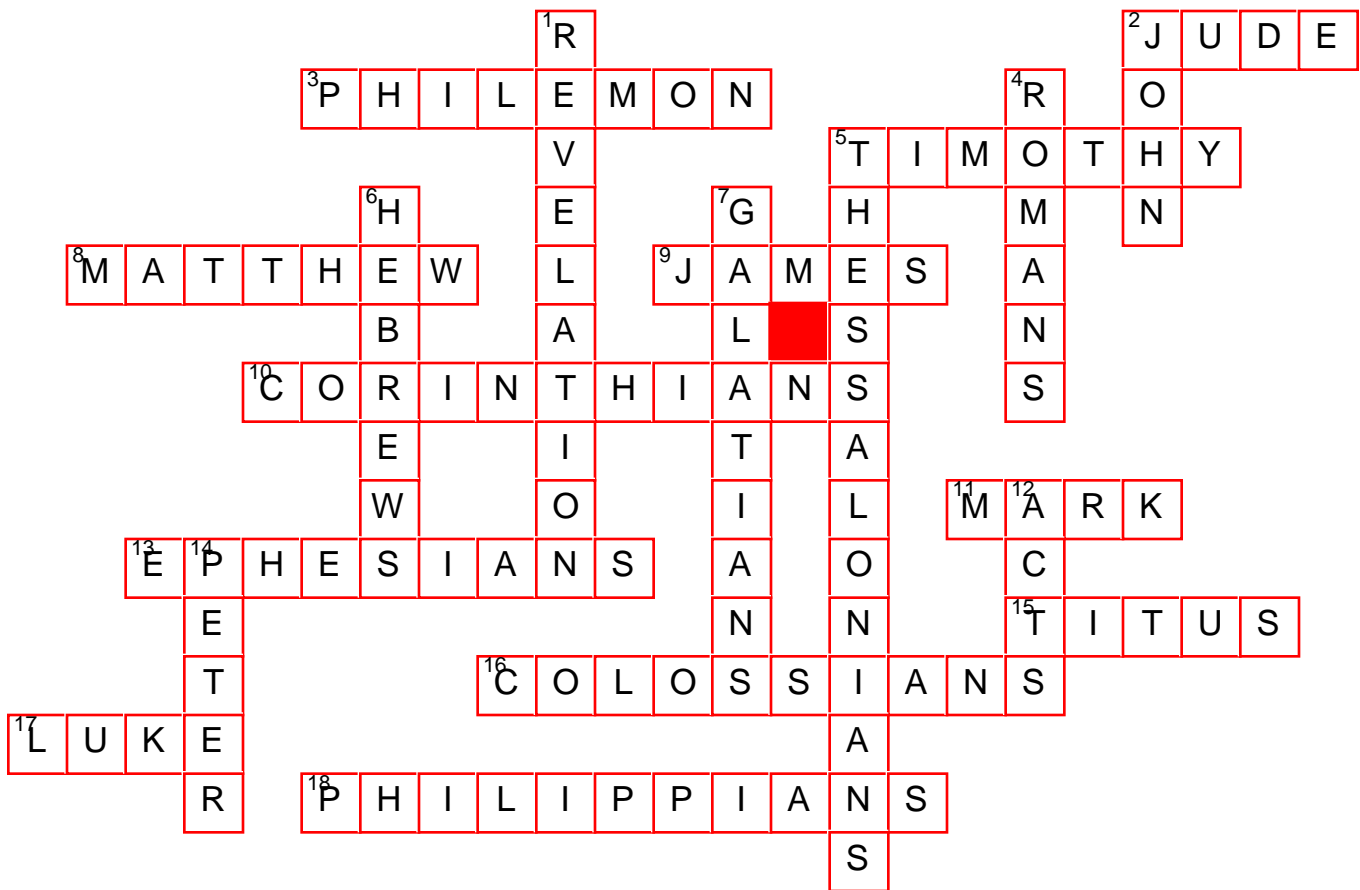


# Books of the New Testament

3. Paul's shortest letter. Sent to the master of the slave Onesimus. [PHILEMON]
5. One of 2 letters containing advice from Paul to his younger colleague. [TIMOTHY]
8. The 1st book in the New Testament. [MATTHEW]
9. A book attributed to the brother of Jesus. Also the name of one of the apostles. [JAMES]
10. Paul wrote 2 letters to Christians in a Greek city known for its wild ways. [CORINTHIANS]
11. The 1st Gospel written but the 2nd one in the Bible. [MARK]
13. A book attributed to Paul in which he urges wives to submit to their husbands, and husbands to love their wives. [EPHESIANS]
15. A letter attributed to Paul which describes the requirements and duties of elders and bishops. [TITUS]

1. The only apocalyptic book in the New Testament. [REVELATION]
2. This Gospel is not one of the synoptic Gospels. Also the first name of a member of the Beatles. [JOHN]
4. Written by Paul to the people of the xxx Empire. [ROMANS]
5. One of 2 letters by Paul to a group in \_\_\_\_alonian. [THESSALONIANS]
6. The Old Testament is also called the \_\_\_\_ Bible. [HEBREWS]
7. A letter by Paul to a group of Christians who were discussing how Gentiles could convert to Christianity. [GALATIANS]
12. This book is sometimes called Luke 2. [ACTS]
14. The letters named after the apostle who denied Jesus 3 times and then heard a cock crow. [PETER]

16. A letter by Paul to a church in Colossae with false teachers. [COLOSSIANS]
17. The Gospel written by a physician. [LUKE]
18. Paul wrote this letter to one of the earliest churches in Europe. Starts with a P. [PHILIPPIANS]
